



Risk Assessment Patient Questionnaire

Before performing remote (at-home) administration of the capsule, providers must ensure the patient is not at risk for capsule aspiration and/or choking. During a telehealth visit, please review this questionnaire with the patient. **If the patient answers "YES" to any of the following questions, the patient should NOT receive remote administration of the capsule.** Additionally, to further assess if a patient may experience difficulties swallowing the capsule, you may choose to review current and past medicine that the patient has taken in a pill form to compare pill size to capsule size. The CapsoCam Plus capsule endoscope is 11mm (diameter) x 31mm (length).
